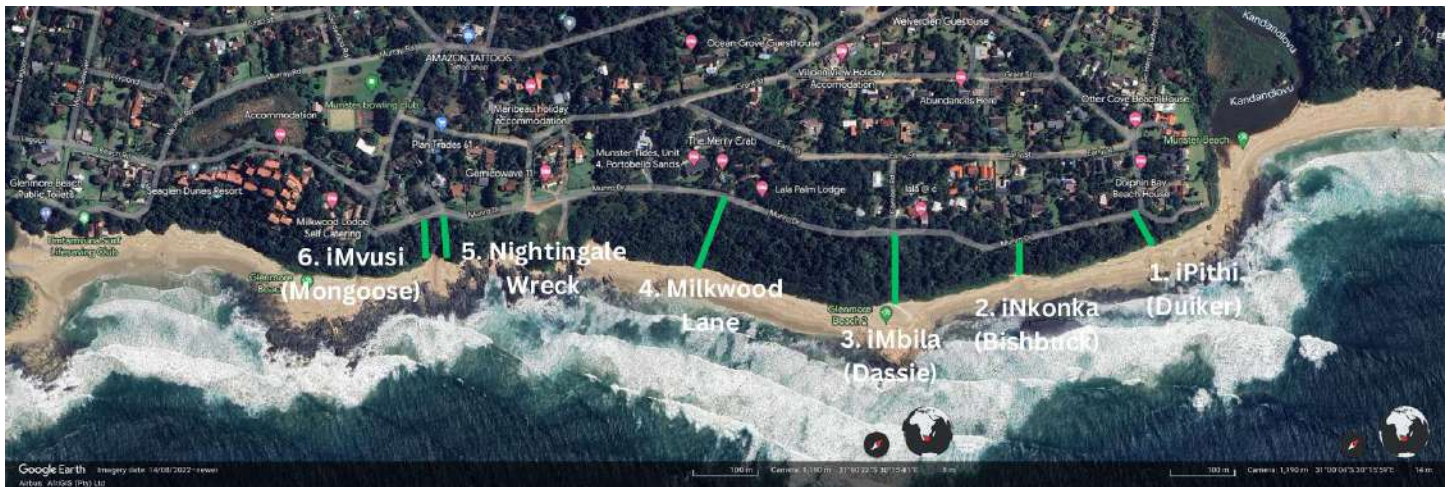


Munster Admiralty Paths

A Munster Conservancy Project

October 2023



The admiralty reserve forms part of the range of zones that describe the coast along with the seashore, coastal waters and coastal buffer zone. It is generally described as a strip of land between 150 to 200 feet (45 m to 60 m) wide, inland of the high-water mark. It serves as a development restriction zone, links coastal and inland biodiversity, creates dune stability and prevents coastal erosion.
